A Look Inside the Classroom

To learn and practice map skills, **High School students** have created imaginary islands in fun "Royal" shapes. They will place their island in a water body and learn about their climate.

Geology students have been studying streams and erosion. To further aid in their understanding, they've viewed real life examples, conducted a soap erosion experiment, and used a stream table to test how volume and slope affect erosion and a stream's physical characteristics.

Puzzle Corner
