Matt Cave is near the lead in the 300 meter hurdles with a time of 47.3 seconds. David Moen is near the top in the 100 meter hurdles with a time of 19.4 seconds. Others are doing very well as well: Cody Cole has already set our school records in the 1600 and 3200 meter runs & Victor Bayouk is very close to breaking our 800 meter record.
