A look inside the classrooms...

Consumer Math Class is working on a "real world" budget for life after graduation. They are researching regional costs for such things as Housing, Utilities, Transportation, Food, Insurances, etc. Students are using the internet to find this information. They will then compare the financial cost of living with types of employment that will meet those costs. This is a real eye opener for our High Schoolers.

Secondary Computer Lab students are reviewing online Christian Devotional websites. This includes researching essential Christian doctrine with which to evaluate the devotional sites. Such questions as "Who put the sites together and how trustworthy are they?" and "What established Christian organizations endorse the websites?" The information collected is to be presented in report form in an MS Word document and presented in a power point presentation. The goal is for the students to learn to investigate the essentials of Christianity and to use true doctrine to evaluate the world around them. Also the students will hopefully find online Christian resources that they can use for years to come. The students are also learning different ways to publish information effectively. May they know the truth so well that they can easily identify counterfeit doctrines.
