Veterans Day Chapel was attended by 4 Veterans spanning WWII-Current. One of the veterans has just finished his 24th year, is still serving in the reserves and is signing up for 6 more years. We began the program with Mr. Frunz reading a very thoughtful letter from President Bush. Mrs. Henningsgaard's father was the main speaker. Her dad brought in pictures and his granddaughter (Mrs. H's daughter) to assist with the presentation. He talked about his service in the Korean War, the duties he was assigned as bayonet instructor, the family life of an enlisted man, survival combat, and patriotism in general. He showed a picture of his entire company and said that everybody knew each other even though they were from many different walks of life—unity was essential. We asked all veteran and active military men and women as well as those with family currently serving in the military to come up front for prayer. At the end of the Chapel, the veterans stood near the exit doors and greeted all of the students with handshakes. It was one of the highlights! Several of the veterans have since contacted us to tell us how much that Chapel meant to them! They all agreed that it was so important to them to receive letters of gratitude—as active military personnel and as veterans. Many classes are currently preparing to send care packages to soldiers in Iraq for Christmas.
