The math classes were treated to a presentation about Pi (Greek letter π). This is the symbol for the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter. It was presented by Boeing Engineer David Wright. He demonstrated pi to the Algebra 1, Pre-algebra, and Math 8/7 students.

Physics students made layden jars to store static electricity.

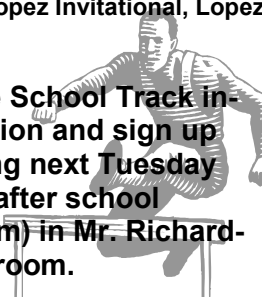
